Paris and Limoges

On October 15, 2013 board your overnight flight, your tour begins the next day.

October 16, 2013 - Arrive in Paris, France

Upon arrival in Paris, meet your Globus Tour Director for a brief ORIENTATION TOUR of the city with a stop for an independent lunch on your own before arriving at the hotel for check-in. Enjoy an included DINNER at the hotel tonight. (D)

October 17, 2013 - Paris

Sightseeing with a Local Guide features the Arc de Triomphe, Opéra, Madeleine, Louvre, and Champs-Élysées. Visit magnificent NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL, and for a panoramic view, take the elevator to the TOP OF THE EIFFEL TOWER. Enjoy an included LUNCH and then a visit to the MUSEE DES ARTS DECORATIFS. Return to the hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure. (B,L)

October 18, 2013 - Paris. Excursions to Sevres

Enjoy the morning at leisure. Transfer to Sevres for a visit to the SEVRES MUSEUM. Return to hotel and later enjoy an included dinner at CESAR PIZZA followed by a CRUISE ON THE RIVER SEINE. (B,D)

October 19, 2013 - Paris

Today a round-trip transfer is provided so you can shop at the Marche Aux Puces, the famous Paris flea market, where you just might find that hidden Haviland treasure. The remainder of the day is at leisure. (B)

October 20, 2013 - Paris

Enjoy the day at leisure. Your Tour Director will have plenty of suggestions on Optional tours available. (B)

October 21, 2013 - Paris-Limoges Area

Journey south today to Limoges. Enjoy an included LUNCH along the way. ORIENTATION TOUR of the city before checking into the hotel. DINNER is included this evening. (B,L,D)

October 22, 2013 - Limoges

Today we visit the Haviland Museum, Outlet Store and Factory, where we will enjoy a guided tour. Lunch at a wonderful Chinese Buffet is included. We will be guests of the Segonds in the afternoon, followed by dinner on your own and a free evening. (B, L)

October 23, 2013 - Limoges

In the morning we will visit the Bernardaud Museum & Lachaniette. After an included lunch, we will spend the afternoon touring the MUSEE ADRIEN DUBOUCHE, the spectacular, newly renovated museum of French porcelain. Dinner on own. (B,L)



October 15 - October 27, 2013

October 24, 2013 - Limoges

Today we visit Saint -Yrieix-la-Perche, the site of the first kaolin deposits. After lunch, we will tour the Coussac-Bonneval Castle and stop at the Atelier La Seynie. Dinner on your own. (B,L)

October 25, 2013 - Limoges-Castle Country-Loire Valley

A rich day of sightseeing. Visit the jewel of the French Renaissance, Château CHAMBORD, and the 16th-century Château of Catherine de Medici, lovely CHENONCEAU. Time for lunch at leisure. On to Amboise. Visit CLOS LUCÉ and marvel at an amazing collection of models of Leonardo da Vinci's inventions, painstakingly reconstructed from the drawings of the great renaissance genius. Check into your hotel in the Loire Valley for the evening. Later, savor a THREE-COURSE FRENCH DINNER WITH DRINKS at a lovely restaurant. (B,D)

October 26, 2013 - Loire Valley-Chartres-Paris

This morning, visit Chartres with its superb 13th-century gothic CATHEDRAL—a jewel of medieval architecture. Arrive in Paris in the afternoon. Enjoy a FAREWELL DINNER at a local restaurant this evening. (B,D)

October 27, 2013 - Paris

A group transfer is provided to the Paris airport this morning. (B)
